- 4 The Management is also responsible for ensuring:
 - a. utilization of funds for the purpose these have been raised; and
 - b. compliance with the requirements of the ICDR Regulations.

Auditor's Responsibility

- 5 Pursuant to the requirements of Clause (9)(F)(1) of Part A of Schedule VI of the ICDR Regulations, it is our responsibility to obtain limited assurance and conclude as to whether the details provided in the Statement is in agreement with the audited books of accounts and other records for the restated consolidated financial statements for the financial period ended March 31, 2024 and liability incurred post-date of latest audited restated consolidated financial statement.
- 6 We have conducted our examination of the Statement in accordance with the Guidance Note on Reports or Certificates for Special Purposes issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The Guidance Note requires that we comply with the ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.



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- We have complied with the relevant applicable requirements of the Standard on Quality Control (SQC) 1, Quality Control for Firms that Perform Audits and Reviews of Historical Financial Information, and Other Assurance and Related Services Engagements.
- A limited assurance engagement includes performing procedures to obtain sufficient appropriate evidence that vary in nature, timing and extent than a reasonable assurance engagement. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had we performed a reasonable assurance engagement. Accordingly, we have performed the following procedures in relation to the Statement:
 - Obtained list of sources of funds for the project from the management and traced the amounts to the books of accounts for the period ended on July 22, 2024;
 - Obtained details of deployment of funds for the project and traced the amount of deployment of funds mentioned in the Statement to the books of accounts for the period ended on July 22, 2024;
 - Conducted relevant management inquiries and obtained necessary representation.
- We have no responsibility to update this report for events and circumstances occurring after the date of this report.

10 Based on our examination as above, and the information and explanations given to us, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the details provided in the Statement are not in agreement with the audited books of accounts and other records for the financial years ended March 31, 2024, 2023 and 2022.
